Klondike Campout - Personal Gear List

Seven Rivers District will hold the 2010 Klondike event at the Walpole Sportsman Club in Walpole, MA. A full day program is planned on February 13th. Scouts camping overnight on Friday night need to plan accordingly, as you will be sleeping in a tent. The following equipment, clothing, and personal items are recommended. However, if your son does not have a specific item, a substitution should be made to provide similar functionality.

Sleeping

- Sleep clothes - please note that it is winter and you will be sleeping outdoors, but in a tent
- Outdoor sleeping bag - appropriate for the prevailing temperature
- Pillow
- Sleeping pad - you don't want to put a sleeping bag on frozen ground

Clothing (Suggestions for an overnight outdoor camping event)

- Underwear and Longjohns
- Socks (4 Pairs)
- Sweater / Polar Fleece
- Pants
- Heavy Jacket
- Hat
- Gloves
- Rain jacket
- Long Sleeve Shirts
- Extra pair of footwear (hiking boots, sneakers, etc) if possible. All of the activities will be taking place outside.
